When A Pill Alone Won't Fix It | Veterinarians and trainers working together to improve canine behavior problems

DR. ELIZABETH ALVAREZ | Behavioral diagnoses in dogs include separation anxiety, noise phobia, aggression of many types, and compulsive disorders. Behavioral drugs are best used in combination with behavior modification guidelines that utilize positive instructions to the pet. They are a useful adjunct to behavioral treatment plans. The objective of this talk will be to present the basic classes of currently used behavioral drugs along with their uses and side effects. Case examples where behavioral drugs would be an important part of a comprehensive behavioral treatment program will also be discussed.

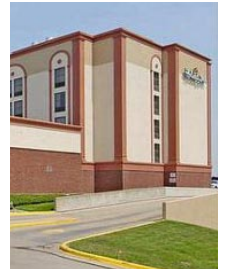
